

Post of Choice Guidelines



Post Selection Timeline:

- After the branching boards are complete the Post Selection board convenes
- Your signed Post of Choice contract should be IN your Accessions Packet
- Open to all branches except Aviation selected for Active Duty
- Volunteering to participate in the program does not guarantee being selected for the Post of Choice program
 - However, HRC considers Post of Choice volunteers first when branching
 - A limited number of post assignments may be available
 - Selection depends on branch and availability dates after BOLC

Post of Choice Guidelines



- Cadets must sign a contract addendum
 - Cadet will incur an <u>additional 3 year</u> ADSO
- Volunteers who are not selected for the Post of Choice:
 - Will receive assignments from DA G1 through the normal assignment process
 - Will not incur the additional 3 year ADSO
- You may participate in up to 2 programs
 - Cadets may volunteer for Post of Choice if they have been selected for Branch of Choice or volunteered for the CSP Graduate School Program
